ORDINARY ? TIME

June begins the long season of "Sundays after Pentecost" or what is more frequently known as "Ordinary Time". This runs for 26 Sundays — one-half of the calendar year in 2007. This begins with Trinity Sunday on June 3 and ends with Christ the King on the last Sunday of November.

Most of the Sundays use the liturgical color green. It is a time of lessons about the life and ministry of Jesus from Luke's Gospel and the Old Testament saga of the prophets, starting with Elijah.

It is called "Ordinary" as opposed to the two special cycles of

Advent-Christmas-Epiphany
&
Lent-Easter-Day of Pentecost.

The "Seasons after..." occur between Epiphany (Jan. 6) and Ash Wednesday and again after Pentecost and before Advent 1.

In our worship life, we use the Church's newer supplemental eucharistic prayers at the 10 a.m. service while at 8 a.m., we use the more traditional "Rite 2" services. We are looking at adding one of the liturgies out of the new worship book of the Evangelical Lutheran Church. Stay tuned!!!

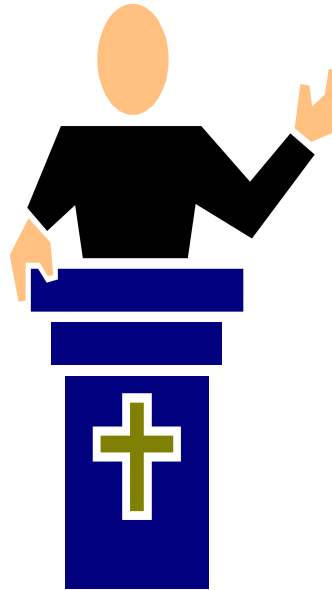
